### **Briefings**

On our Web site, we publish daily news, analysis and opinion “briefings” concerning issues of current importance. We especially seek articles that would be of interest and importance for U.S. and Western policymakers. These briefings are generally 700-900 words in length, though we may consider longer contributions in special cases. These articles should look beyond the basic facts to offer our readers context and insight. Briefings can contain strong opinions but should not be shrill or strident in tone.

Briefings should be written so that they will last for at least one week. We try to publish timely articles as soon as possible, but publication may not occur for several days.

We pay a \$100 honorarium for articles that have not been published elsewhere previously. In special cases, we may occasionally publish work that has appeared elsewhere.

### **In-Depth Feature Articles**

We publish 6-7 feature articles per month that appear in the subscription-only portion of our Web site, as well as in our bimonthly (six issues/year) digital journal. These articles are 2,500-4,000-word in-depth analyses. Typically, we commission these articles directly from writers, but compelling unsolicited submissions will be considered.

### **Video**

We are interested in raw or edited video for video reports of 1:30 to 4 minutes. Payment will depend on length, quality, etc.

### **Blog**

We do not pay for blog contributions, but we invite and encourage submissions.

### **Audio**

Our audio section mostly features aggregated reports and interviews from other providers. However, we will occasionally produce exclusive audio reports and interviews of 2-6 minutes in length.
